 - **Services Offered:** The St. Clair County Housing Authority (SCCHA) houses two basic types of federally assisted housing program. Property based assistance programs and a tenant-based assistance program. The tenant-based program is called the Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher Program (HCVP), which provides rental assistance to participating families residing in privately owned dwellings. There are three types of property-based programs:
 - Public Housing (18 different locations)
 - Multi-Family Housing (locations in Brooklyn and Belleville)
 - Rural Development Housing (locations in Lebanon and St. Libory). Provides housing for low-income and middle-income families.
